Course at-a-Glance

This small field-of-view cone beam CT (CBCT) course has both didactic and “hand’s on” computer-based components that will introduce the clinician to the principles of CBCT and its applications in dentistry. The course content is consistent with the educational guidelines of the College of Dental Surgeons of Saskatchewan for the operation of CBCT systems.

Course Objectives

- The biological effects of ionizing radiation and radiation dosimetry.
- Normal anatomy and variations.
- Image interpretation.
- Benign space-occupying lesions.
- Inflammation and malignant neoplasia.
- Temporomandibular joint imaging.
- Dento-alveolar trauma.
- Dysplastic lesions of bone.
- Dental implant imaging and image processing.
- Limitations, reporting and case selection.

Important Things to Note

Participants will **require a laptop** that was purchased within the past 4 years for this course. The laptop **MUST** be PC-based (unless your Apple computer has Windows parallels installed), and it **MUST** have at least 1 free USB port.

Following the course, Dr. Lam will distribute an examine which is to be completed within two weeks of the course.
