CDSS Neuromodulators, Botox and Other Injectable Standard

The College of Dental Surgeons of Saskatchewan authorizes the therapeutic administration of neuromodulators and other injectable treatments in the oral-facial complex for 'therapeutic purposes' in the treatment of diseases, disorders, dysfunction, including therapy in conjunction with or follow-up to orthognathic surgery within the license provisions of an oral and maxillofacial surgeon. An oral medicine specialist is authorized for the therapeutic administration of neuromodulators and other injectable treatments in the oral-facial complex for 'therapeutic purposes' in the treatment of diseases, disorders, and dysfunction. Administration of neuromodulators or other injectable treatments for 'cosmetic purposes' is not authorized for either CDSS general dentists or CDSS dental specialists. Patients may be referred by CDSS members to other health care professionals for the administration of 'Cosmetic Botox or other injectables.'
